

Yolo County 4H Scholarship Application

The Yolo County 4H Scholarship is open for all members, youth and adults, to apply to be used to attend events and conferences that will support and promote the continued growth and leadership skills of the members.

If possible, it is recommended that you apply for the scholarship at least two months prior to the deadlines for submitting registration and fees or other expenses. This is to allow the necessary time for the Scholarship Committee to review the application and then bring the recommendation back to the Leaders Council for approval of the recommendation. As the meetings are monthly, there will be a lag between application and approval. It should be noted that a scholarship grant can be awarded in arrears to reimburse the member for fees and expenses paid to meet deadlines while the application is being processed; however there is no guarantee the total amount requested will be awarded.

The Leaders Council encourages members to use all means of fundraising to assist in covering the cost of events and the potential Scholarship Grant awarded as an augmentation to the fundraising.

The Completed Scholarship Application may be [downloaded from the 4H web page](#), or requested from your Community Club Leader or the 4H Office. The completed application should be submitted to your Community Club Leader who will then present it to the Scholarship Committee.
